Lulingu

**Lulingu** lives at the GRACE Gorillas Sanctuary in Democratic Republic of the Congo, Africa. She is part of a large group of rescued Grauer's gorillas who have now formed a family! Meet a few of the GRACE gorillas that have extra special connections to Lulingu:



Pinga

**Pinga** is one of the highest ranking females in the group. She has been an adoptive mother for many of the gorillas at GRACE, including Lulingu. Although Lulingu is growing up, Pinga remains close to her. She is often seen resting, eating or sleeping near Lulingu.



Amani

**Amani** loves to play with Lulingu and the other young gorillas. Her name means "Peace" in KiSwahili, which is fitting, because Amani tries to be friends with everyone in the gorilla group.



Ndjingala

**Ndjingala** likes to spend time with the other gorillas. Her best friend is Amani, whom she has known since they were both rescued as infants. Ndjingala is very playful. She is often seen playing with or caring for Lulingu and the younger gorillas at GRACE.



Muyisa

**Muyisa** wants to be near other gorillas as much as possible, especially the younger gorillas. When Lulingu first arrived at GRACE, Muyisa practiced carrying Lulingu on her back, like a mother gorilla would do.
