SUBJECT: LOS ANGELES ZOO ANIMAL TRANSACTIONS AND STATUS

REPORT

The following is a list of animal transactions that have been approved. Funds from sales transactions will be deposited into the City's Animal Purchases and Sales account. All receiving institutions are accredited by the Association of Zoos and Aquariums (AZA) unless otherwise noted. Animal transactions support the Zoo's commitment to population management through participation in AZA Species Survival Plan (SSP) Program recommendations, animal welfare and conservation efforts. Transactions reflect loans, purchases and sales and include animals that are owned by the Los Angeles Zoo, but reside in the care of other AZA-accredited or approved institutions.

#### LOANS

Loan transfer from Jacksonville Zoo in Florida of 0.1 Giant otter. This transaction will provide the Los Angeles Zoo with a breeding female.

Loan from Wildlife Safari in Winston, Oregon of 3.0 Ring-tailed lemur. This transaction is an SSP recommendation.

Loan transfer from Dallas World Aquarium in Texas of 1.0 Giant otter. This transaction will provide the Los Angeles Zoo with a breeding male.

Loan from Charles Paddock Zoo in Atascadero, California of 0.1 Red-flanked duiker. This transaction is an SSP breeding recommendation.

Loan transfer to Philadelphia Zoo in Pennsylvania of 0.1 Geoffroy's marmoset. This transaction is an SSP breeding recommendation.

Sale to Cincinnati Zoo and Botanical Gardens in Ohio of 1.0 Southern tamandua. This transaction is an SSP recommendation.

Sale to Virginia Zoo in Norfolk, Virginia of 0.1 Binturong. This transaction is an SSP recommendation.

Sale to Saint Louis Zoo in Missouri of 1.1 Tawny frogmouth. This transaction fulfills internal species planning needs.

Sale to Sedgwick County Zoo in Wichita, Kansas of 0.1 Cape thick-knee. This transaction is an SSP recommendation.

Sale to Zoo Miami in Florida of 2.1 Raggianna bird-of-paradise. This transaction fulfills internal species planning needs.
